

### **COUNCIL MINUTES — January 14, 2025**

Please note: these minutes have been edited for the newsletter.

The full minutes are posted on the bulletin board in the office hallway.

### Pastor's Report:

- ◆ Confirmation resumed "Lutheran Living"
- Finalized budget and stewardship is done.
- Working on cottage meeting planning and policy manual
- Been asked to host Theological Conference in the fall

#### **Deacon's Report:**

- Lovely Christmas worships, earlier service was attended by more than the second.
- Choir will do a choral event on Palm Sunday.
- Christina Nath is considering a Children's hand bell choir
- February 2 Pastor Chris Matson from Church on the Street will be here for worship
- Attended Prairie Rivers Conference
- Performed a funeral for Elaine Duvall.

### **Ministry Reports:**

- Faith Formation: Nine milestones for this year. The calendar is available. High School Bible study tomorrow night. Middle Schoolers will go to Faith Fest at Augustana on February 8. Camp weeks are July 20 and July 27.
- Stewardship: (given by Pastor Scott) Waves of Blessing is the theme this year and will include three challenges: increase for regular givers, first time givers and one time gift to the building fund. Hope to be in the mail this week.
- ◆ Property: Have not received a bid for the bell tower tuck pointing. We are experiencing a little water in the basement bathroom. Thinks it's caused by condensation rather than a leak. Bought a leaf blower to blow snow. Keeping an eye on the water heaters as they are getting close to end of life. It will be a substantial cost when replacement is necessary. Tessiers did provide a new contract for maintenance, \$3,120 for the year. The final amount for the water bill credit was \$4,143, some applied in December, the rest will be this year.
- Evangelism: (given by Pastor Scott) The direct mail was sent out before Christmas. Will probably do again for Easter.

**Reception of the Treasurer's Report:** December income \$40,792.20; expenses \$36,284.87. Net ordinary income for December was \$4, 507.33. Year to Date net ordinary income is \$441,207.98 and total expenses was \$440,381.80 leaving a net ordinary income for the year \$826.18. Steve made a motion to receive the Treasurer's report, seconded by Amanda Schutz. Motion carried.

New Business: Pam moved to approve the proposed budget, Steve seconded. Motion passed. Annual Meeting, Sunday, January 26, 2025 following worship.



February 23 at Trinity Lutheran. Registration starts at 2:00 p.m. with the meeting beginning at 2:30 p.m.



The Prairie Rivers Scholarship is for students planning to attend, or presently enrolled in an ELCA college (Augustana, Concordia, St. Olaf, Gustavus, etc.) Applications can be picked up in the church office.

The Valentine cookie project began in 2016 and has helped fund 46 scholarships to First Lutheran students pursuing post-secondary education. Those 46 scholarships have been



funded entirely by money raised during the year - rummage sale, noisy offering, and the cookie project. Thus, the money from the original scholarship fund, dating back to 2002, which was given only to students attending an ELCA college/university, has not been used to fund the 46 scholarships. The church council voted to invest that original scholarship money and hopefully it will eventually generate funds for future scholarships.


